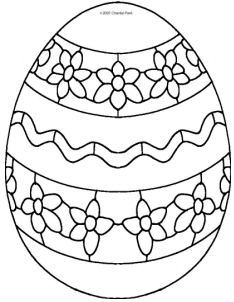


Biggest Chocolate Egg!



Approximately 50,000 people gathered on Sunday in the Argentine city of Bariloche to taste the world's biggest handmade Easter egg. According to the local tourism service, 17,637 pounds of chocolate went into making the giant Easter treat, which stood 27.9 feet high and boasted a 19.7 feet diameter. A large number of chefs from the local association of chocolate makers, an organization which brings together about 18 local producers, worked to create the massive egg. Bariloche is renowned for its local tourism offerings, beautiful landscape and tradition of chocolate production.

Stamp Misquotes Maya Angelou

The author Maya Angelou, who died last year aged 86, has been honored with a stamp issued by America's postal service. Unfortunately, the line that sits alongside her portrait isn't hers. Angelou is best-known for her 1969 memoir *I Know Why The Caged Bird Sings*, and the USPS appears to have taken the accompanying quotation. "A bird doesn't sing because it has an answer, it sings because it has a song," certainly seems a good fit, except that it comes from *A Cup of Sun*, a collection of poetry by Joan Walsh Anglund published two years before Angelou's memoir.
